A combination of warm and versatile clothing is recommended for exploring the city. Daytime dress code is casual and smart casual for dinners.

## Clothing

- Rain jacket and umbrella
- Scarf or shawl
- Swimsuit, swim caps, and flip flops (for thermal baths)
